LEAD SERVICE — SECTION 504 RAPID COMPLIANCE ASSESSMENT

The HHS Section 504 web and mobile accessibility deadline passed on May 11, 2026. Recipients of HHS federal financial assistance that were not conformant are now exposed to Office for Civil Rights complaints. ADA Access for All delivers a fixed-fee, four-week Section 504 Rapid Compliance Assessment — WCAG 2.1 AA audit, 45 CFR Part 84 gap analysis, written Compliance Plan, and credentialed attestation — built for OCR response. ADA Title II (April 2027 / April 2028 deadlines) and Section 508 follow as the firm’s Year-two and baseline service lines.

WHO WE ARE

ADA Access for All is a specialized accessibility services firm delivering federally-defensible WCAG conformance testing, Section 504 and Section 508 compliance assessments, ADA Title II Self-Evaluations and Transition Plans, VPAT 2.5 / ACR production, and ADA Coordinator advisory services to public-sector and HHS-funded organizations. The firm is led by Marc Guillaume, holder of the DHS Trusted Tester for Web certification (the federal Section 508 testing standard), the University of Missouri ADA Coordinator Certification, an MA in Urban Policy and Administration, and a BA in Philosophy and Law.
